Easy-to-understand communication is the presentation of content units of information appearing in common language or at a more complex language level, or the development of independent information content in a simple, clean form, which serves to understand the information. In the practice of easy-to-understand communication, grammar, as the entire system of language, is often applied according to unique rules. When using easy-to-understand communication, an important principle is to involve an experienced expert in the work and to check the finished content.
