Judit Gombás PhD is a full-time, associate professor at ELTE Bárczi Gusztáv Faculty of Special Needs Education (Budapest, Hungary). She earned her PhD in 2017. Her doctoral research focused on the leisure sport habits of Hungarian individuals with blindness or visual impairment. She is the Hungarian representative of the International Council for the Education and Re/habilitation of People with Visual Impairment (ICEVI). She is a founder and former president of Hungarian Sports and Leisure Association for the visually Impaired (LÁSS).

The main fields of Dr. Gombás' scientific interest are the challenges of adults with visual impairment (e.g. parenting and work), re/habilitation, and adapted physical activity. As a blind person, she advocates for the full social inclusion of individuals with visual impairment. She strongly believes that people with disabilities have the potential to add values to a better World, to which their equitable education is the key.
